



Craft template: EGG CARTON WHALE

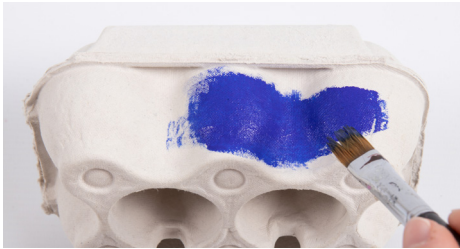


What will I need?

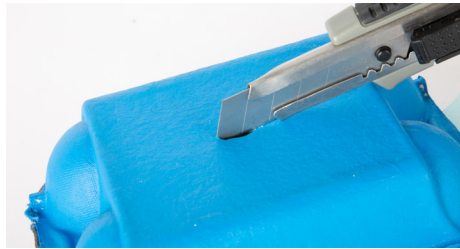
- egg carton
- glue
- scissors
- felt pen
- acrylic paint
- chestnuts
- craft paper
- white paper
- cutter knife

Caution:

Steps with sharp tools or materials such as the cutter knife must only be done by adults!



1 First, colour the egg carton with acrylic paints.



2 After the paint is dry, cut a slit in the top portion of the egg carton with the cutter knife.



3 Next, cut a slit into the chestnuts.



4 Next, cut small triangles out of the craft paper and stick them into the slits in the chestnuts.



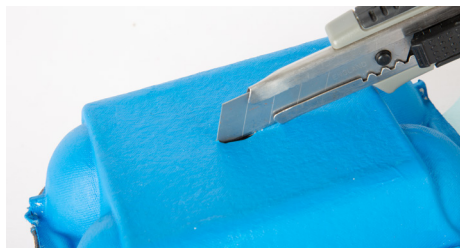
5 Then, make cuts in the white paper at regular intervals. Make sure that at least 3 cm are left uncut at the other end.



6 Now it's time to use your creativity! The little „fish“ can now be painted. Also, cut the fins out of the craft paper.



7 In the next step, carefully roll the sliced white paper up along the long side. The uncut side will then be inserted in the slit on the top of the egg carton.



8 Finally, glue the whale's fins onto the carton.



9 Lastly, you can cut out small water waves from the remaining craft paper so that the whale can be in his familiar environment. You can also give your whale a cute face!
